

A Word About Today's Service

Today we begin a 5-week worship series on Half Truths, based on the book by Methodist pastor and theologian, Adam Hamilton. Over the next five weeks we will look at some very common phrases people of faith use to explain suffering, the seeming randomness of life, and what we believe to be words of comfort in times of need. But these phrases, as well intentioned as they may be, only tell half of the truth about God and Jesus Christ, and sometimes not even that much! Through careful study of the Scriptures, we will learn new ways of accessing and sharing the good news of our faith with others!

Everything happens for a reason. We've all heard this before, usually at a time of great pain, loss, or suffering. But is it true? Did the Holocaust happen for a reason? What about the war currently raging in Ukraine? Did God cause or turn a blind eye to the drunk driver who struck and killed a family on their way home from the movies? What about personal choice? These questions, and more, shape our worship today.
