 like them, the meek and low-ly, may live e-ter-nal-ly.

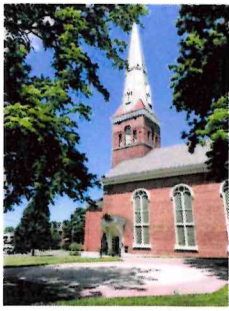


